ACP Players Levy

The Players Levy is an annual fee charged by the Australian Canoe Polo Technical Committee, and is applicable to all individuals actively playing canoe polo in Australia.

The Queensland Canoe Polo committee will collect this levy through one of the main State co-ordinated events.

The 2013 levy therefore must be collected at the first competition each player competes in, this being either the 2013 State Championships or the 2013 Winter Championships.

A register of individuals who have paid this levy will be maintained and will be used to determine the levy payment upon receipt of notification of levy dues from ACP.

Trial Canoeist Fee

The Trial Canoeist is a fee charged by Australian Canoeing, which enables individuals to participate in canoeing activities, who are not currently a member of a canoe club affiliated to a State Association that is a financial member of Australian Canoeing. This fee covers the individual under the Australian Canoeing Insurance Policy and enables the individual to trial a maximum of 3 triallist attempts before joining a club.

Competition Rules

The 2013 Queensland Autumn Canoe Polo Competition is conducted under the regulations and guidelines contained in the ICF Canoe Polo Rules. It is the responsibility of the competitors to be familiar with the regulations. Copies are available from the International Canoe Federation Online – <http://www.canoeicf.com>

Eligibility

All players must be a member of a canoe club affiliated to a State Association that is a financial member of Australian Canoeing OR otherwise must pay the Trial Canoeist Fee.

All competitors must comply with the applicable QC & AC Rules, including the Anti-doping bylaw, sponsorship policy and the Member Protection Bylaw. Copies can be downloaded from Queensland Canoeing Online – www.qld.canoe.org.au

All Teams must be available for official duties (1x time keeper, 1x scorer, 2x goal line controllers)

Scrutineering

Random scrutineering may take place prior to and during the competition. Prior to the competition day, please ensure that:

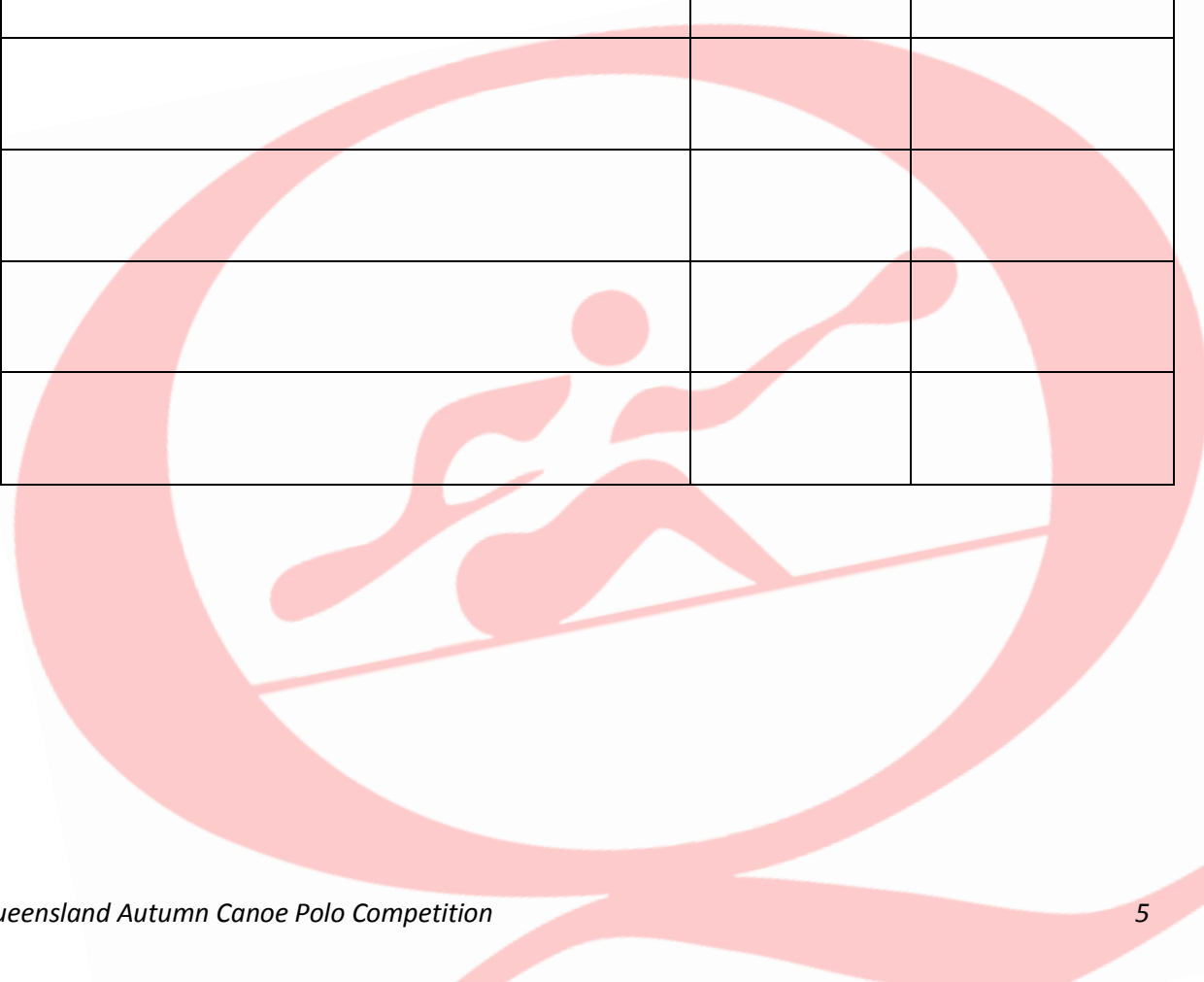
- Paddles and kayaks have no sharp edges.
- Bumpers are attached correctly and have sufficient compression.
- Helmets and PFDs are fitted correctly.
- Playing shirts with numbers are easily read.
- Each Team should have a repair kit for the above equipment in case of repairs needed during competition.
